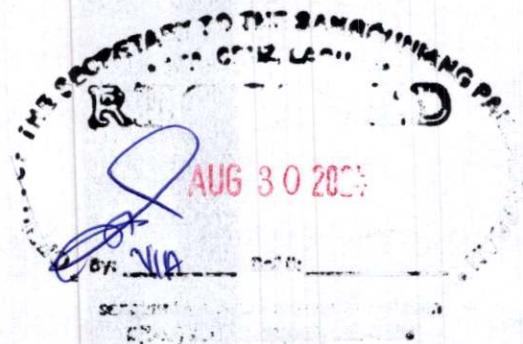

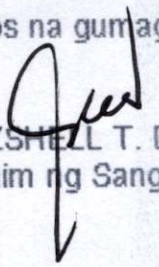

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GUIDELINES FOR THE REGISTRATION AND ACCREDITATION OF CAVINTI BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS (BHWs) AND BARANGAY NUTRITION SCHOLARS (BNSs) GRANTING THEM ADDITIONAL BENEFITS AND INCENTIVES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

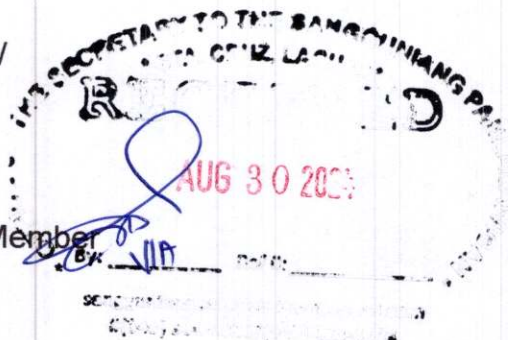

WHEREAS, Barangay Health Workers are the frontline service providers at the community level;

WHEREAS, Barangay Health Workers (BHWs) have been part of the Philippine Health Care System since the 80's as a component of the country's adherence to the 1978 Alma-Ata declaration on Primary Health Care, Which considers the important role played by community health workers;

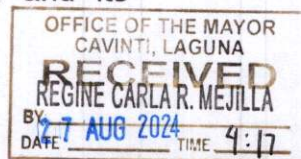
WHEREAS, BHWs are covered by the provisions of R.A. No. 7883, otherwise known as BHWs Benefits and Incentives Act of 1995, and its

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Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), which specifies their three (3) main responsibilities: (1) community organizers, (2) health educators, and (3) primary care provider;

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Act to set the system for Barangay Health Workers to gain access to packages or resources and opportunities for improving their personal and professional development;

WHEREAS, BHWs are health human resources that play a central role in the development, implementation, monitoring and assessment of health and development programs in the barangays;

WHEREAS, the Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 7883 define the Barangay Health Workers' roles and responsibilities, the procedures and requirements the BHWs may undertake so that they can avail of the benefits and incentives;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Nutrition Scholars Program aim to implement nutrition programs, projects, and activities and increase community participation to address malnutrition;

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNSs) is covered by Presidential Decree No. 1569, otherwise known as "Strengthening the Barangay Nutrition Program by Providing a Barangay Nutrition Scholar in every Barangay". Providing Funds Therefor and for Other Purposes", which seeks to provide additional human resources for the implementation of programs, projects and activities aimed at addressing malnutrition by requiring at least one BNS per Barangay. It also aims to increase the involvement and participation of the people on nutrition concerns at the grassroots level;

WHEREAS, BNS are considered Barangay-Based-volunteers, who are tasked to deliver nutrition services and other related activities such as community health, backyard food production., environmental sanitation, culture, mental feeding, and family planning to the barangay. As a volunteer, a BNS delivers nutrition and related services to the community without salary. As a scholar, he or she has to continuously upgrade his/her knowledge and skills in order to perform community nutrition work;

WHEREAS, BHWs and BNSs are considered volunteer health human resources receiving monetary and non-monetary benefits depending on their respective local government unit's available resources;

WHEREAS, BHWs and BNSs have undergone relevant training programs under various government and non-government institutions, enabling them to perform their various tasks within their respective barangays;

WHEREAS, in recognition of the services being rendered by BHWs and BNSs who are actively and regularly performing their duties, the Municipality of Cavinti is initiating efforts which will clarify their status and responsibilities, as well as strengthen and institutionalize their benefits and incentives, consistent with policies of the National Government;

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WHEREAS, by addressing the various issues facing BHWs and BNSs, their performance of their respective duties and responsibilities are strengthen, resulting in the improvement of the health system, and the health indicators of the Municipality, in the Rural Health Unit including Health Center, and in the Barangay;

WHEREFORE, In view of the foregoing, the Sangguniang Bayan do hereby ordained

SECTION I - Short Title. This Ordinance shall be known as **"Barangay Health Workers and Barangay Nutrition Scholars Ordinance of Cavinti 2024."**

SECTION II - Declaration of Policies. The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and to instil health consciousness among them:

The Municipal Government recognizes the vital role of BHWs and BNSs in the promotion of health in the Local Government Unit and to this end, the municipality shall strengthen and recognize the rights of BHWs and BNSs to organize themselves to strengthen and systemize their services to the community and to make a venue for sharing their experience and for recommending policies and guidelines for the promotion, maintenance and advancement of their activities and services.

SECTION III- Definition of Terms.

- a) **BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS – (BHWs)** refers to volunteer health workers in the barangays who have undergone training programs in any accredited government or non-government organizations, and who voluntarily render promote, preventive, curative, and rehabilitative services to the residents and communities of their Barangay and to the Municipality of Cavinti after having been accredited to function as such by the Cavinti Barangay Health Workers-Registration Accreditation Committee in accordance with the guidelines provided in this Ordinance.
- b) **BARANGAY NUTRITION SCHOLARS – (BNSs)** refers to volunteers who have undergone training programs in any accredited government or non-government organizations, and voluntarily render nutrition services and other related activities such as community health, backyard food productions, environmental sanitation, culture, mental feeding, and family planning barangay residents of Cavinti have been accredited to function as such by the Cavinti Barangay Nutrition Scholars Registration and Accreditation Committee in accordance with the guidelines in the Ordinance.
- c) **Civil Service Eligibility-** is a sub-professional (second grade) level of qualification granted by the Civil Service Commission to an accredited BHW & BNS in accordance with these rules;

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- d) Community – refers to a barangay , purok, or zone in a rural or urban area , where renders primary health care services;
- e) Cavinti Paid BHWs- refer to BHWs performing volunteer health services in the Barangay, and are under the management and supervision of the Municipal Health Office (MHO) , with funds for their compensation, subsidies , benefits and incentives sourced from the Mayor's Office;
- f) Cavinti Paid BNSs – refer to BNSs performing volunteer works in nutrition in the Barangays under the management and supervision of the Municipal Health office and which funds for their compensation subsidies, benefits and incentives are sourced from the budget of the Mayor's Office;

SECTION IV – BHW Registration and Accreditation Committee –

BHWs shall be entitled in the benefits and incentives provided under this Ordinance. Provided, that they shall be registered and accredited by the Local Health Board (LBH).

To facilitate registration and Accreditation of BHWs, the LHB shall create a BHW registration and Accreditation Committee (BHW-RAC) in accordance with the implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 7883 which shall be composed of the following:

The Local Health Board (LHB) may, however, expand the membership of the BHW-RAC depending on the need for a more efficient system of registration and accreditation.

SECTION V- BHW Qualifications. In order to become a Municipal –Paid BHW, the applicant should have the following qualifications:

- a. At least 18 years old but not more than 50 years old;
- b. At least High School Graduate;
- c. Of good Moral Character;
- d. A bona fide resident of the Barangay;
- e. Undergone Basic Training Course conducted by the Local Health Office or any accredited agency; and

SECTION VI- BHW Duties and Functions. The BHW shall perform the following tasks, with specific examples as stated in R.A. 7883, but not limited to the following:

Community Organizer- He/she shall participate in organizing and mobilizing the community towards self-reliance by:

1. Maintaining regular communication with the community leaders and professional health workers;

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2. Providing linkage between the community and local health agencies;
 3. Assisting the community to develop a health plan and to take action to promote their health well-being;
 4. Facilitating the community members to identify and respond to their community health problems;
 5. Keeping records of the work activities on health; and Developing appropriate knowledge and skills among community members to promote their participation in local health initiatives.
- a. Educator – he/she shall provide knowledge and skills among community members in the prevention and management of simple illness by :
1. Conducting Health classes and /or household teachings;
 2. Updating knowledge of communities on relevant health issues; and
 3. Distributing appropriate information, education, and communication materials.
- b. Health Care Provider- he/she shall render primary health care services to the members of the community by:
1. Providing primary health care services as defined in their knowledge and training;
 2. Referring patients with complications and those suspected to have communicable disease to the appropriate health center or hospital;
 3. Monitoring the health status of the household members under his/her area of service coverage;
 4. Keeping records of health activities in the community and the health station; and
 5. Ensuring the proper maintenance of the health station and the safe custody of tis equipment medical supplies and health records;
- c. Adviser – who will advise & counsel the community on the importance of Immunization, Pre-Post natal visits:
1. Preventive methods to either minimize or control spread of infectious diseases like TB, Dengue, etc;
 2. To disseminate regular communication between local professional health workers and their catchment households;
 3. Distributes IEC materials (if available) while conducting household campaign or counselling.
- d. Linker – to facilitate access to or association of the community with relevant network of health and non-health service providers within or outside their catchment areas:

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Vice Mayor

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1. Knowledgeable as to when and where to refer clients to address specific needs and/or facilities that provide specific services;
 2. Constantly update their household catchment areas on the latest ordinances for health programs or health related activities supported by the local officials/LGU, NGOs, OGAs.
- e. Record Keeper- to maintain updated lists/records of health data, health activities/events in the community:
1. Regularly update family profile of household catchment areas;
 2. Regularly record important information regarding compliance of members of the household catchment areas with the needed medications;
 3. Submit regular report for monthly accomplishments.

SECTION VII – BNS Registration and Accreditation Committee (BNS-RAC). There shall be constituted in Nineteen (19) Barangay in the Municipality of Cavinti the Barangay Nutrition Scholar Registration and Accreditation Committee (BNS-RAC) to be composed of the following:

The BNS-RAC shall submit the list of qualified applicants to the Municipal Agriculturist/Action and Nutrition Officer (MNAO). The Municipal Screening committee composed of the MNAO and two other members of the Municipal Nutrition Committee/Council shall convene to choose the most qualified from among the applicants using the prescribed National Nutrition Council form. The MNAO shall then submit the final list to the MNC Vice Chairman before submitting the same to the Mayor for his approval.

SECTION VIII- BNSs Qualification. In Order to become a Municipal Paid BNS, the applicants should have the following qualifications, pursuant to Section P.D. 1569, to wit:

- a. At least 18 years old but not more than 50 years old at the time of application;
- b. Physically and Mentally fit;
- c. At least High School Graduate;
- d. A bona fide resident of the barangay;
- e. Of good moral character;
- f. With leadership potentials, initiative and willing to serve the barangay;
- g. Willing to learn, and to teach what he/she learned to the barangay residents;

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- h. Have undergone basic training course for BNS conducted by the Nutrition Council and Municipal Nutrition Office or any accredited agency; and

SECTION IX – BNS Roles and Functions. To uplift the quality of life of the people in the Barangay without overlapping with the responsibilities of other barangay based workers, the BNS must focus on the Nutrition Service to alleviate the malnutrition problem in their respective barangays.

- a. Planner – BNS is involved in planning of programs, projects and activities that will be implemented in their respective barangay regarding nutrition services. As a planner, the BNS shall assist the Punong Barangay in organizing or reactivating the Barangay Nutrition Council (BNC) as well as initiate and assist the said BNC in the formulation of the Barangay Nutrition Action Plan (BNAP);
- b. Coordinator – the BNS is responsible for coordinating with the BNC and other health sectors. Particularly, the BNS shall coordinate meetings of the BNC and submit minutes of the meeting to the BNS coordinator, facilitate the nutrition related meetings and coordinate the implementation of nutrition activities;
- c. Advocate and Promoter – it is the duty and responsibility to advocate for the nutrition program among policy and decision makers, implementers and beneficiaries;
- d. Implementers- the BNS shall implement the Nutrition Services under the supervision of the MNAO. It is the duty of the BNS to assist in the implementation of the Barangay Nutrition Action Plan (BNAP);
- e. Monitor and Evaluator – It is the duty of the BNS to find out whether the planned activities were implemented or the set objectives were fulfilled and if programs goals and target were met. The BNS shall be responsible to monitor the nutrition status of the preschool children. It is also their duty to inform, monitor and conduct follow-up visits to mothers/caregivers/parents of the beneficiaries and resource persons to attend the nutrition activities, and the implementation of the Rules and Regulations of Nutrition-related national laws and policies, that is, ASIN LAW, Food Fortification Law, Milk Code and R.A 10028, and provide feedback/updates to the BNC, MNAO, and MNPC.
- f. Record Keeper – it is the duty and responsibility of the BNS to see to it that plans, activities, problems and solutions discussed in a meeting should be documented by written reports and /or photos. Thus, the BNS shall prepare minutes of meetings dutifully and promptly and takes photos of important nutrition activities.

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SECTION X – Provisions Regarding Assistance, Benefits and Incentives.

- a. List of Benefits and Incentives- Subject to the provisions of this rule. BHWs and BNSs who are actively and regularly performing their duties shall be entitled to the following benefits and incentives:
 1. For Accredited BHW and BNS as well as Registered BHW & BNS.
 - a.1.a. Allowance, Honorarium , Travel Claims;
 - a.1.b. Training, Education, and Career Enrichment Programs;
 - a.1.c. Civil Service Eligibility;
 - a.1.d. Special Financial Assistance:
 - i. Separation Benefit

SECTION XI – Allowances, Honorarium, Travel Claims.

- a. Scope- Accredited BHWs and BNSs shall be entitled to receive a monthly allowance/honorarium of at least One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00) from the Municipal Government of Cavinti;
- b. Procedure to avail allowance/honorarium – The accredited BHWs and BNS as well as Registered BHW and BNS entitled to the allowances shall submit monthly itinerary and accomplishment report to the RHU/MNAO Coordinator and Barangay council in triplicate copies in every month or in every quarter months.
- c. Travel Claims – Officers of the BHW Federation/BNS Federation shall be entitled to travel reimbursement when they travel on Official Business (OB) such as training and seminars outside the municipality.
- d. Funding – The allowance, Honorarium, and Travel claims benefits shall be funded by the Supplemental Budget and General fund of the Municipal Local Government of Cavinti or in the Municipal Mayor's Fund.

SECTION XII – Special Financial Assistance. Separation Benefits/Financial Assistance for RETIRING BHWs and BNSs. In recognition of their invaluable voluntary service to the Municipality, the BHWs and BNSs shall be granted financial assistance upon separation from public service, as follows:

- a. Five Thousand Pesos (Php5, 000.00) to qualified BHWs and BNSs having rendered at least fifteen years of continuous service regardless of their age.
- b. Funding- The special financial assistance and benefits on this section shall be funded by the supplemental Budget and

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General Fund of Cavinti, Laguna or in the Municipal Mayor's Office fund.

SECTION XIII – Training, Education, and Career Enrichment Programs.

- a. Scope – The DOH in collaboration with other government agencies, including local government units as well as NGOs , POs, Private Agencies and Institutions, shall provide information and opportunities for training , education and career enrichment programs ;
- b. Available Courses- qualified accredited BHW and BNS may avail of one or more of the following TECEPs offered in the Philippines:
 1. Formal Health Science, education with certificate or diploma, graduate and/or post graduate courses offered by institutions accredited/recognized by the Commission on Higher Education(CHED), including step-ladder curriculum for health sciences;
 2. Formal Vocational Course in Health offered by institutions accredited/recognized by the DOH; and
 3. Trainings and other short term courses on health, with or without certificate, offered by Institutions whose programs have been accredited/ recognized by the DOH; and
 4. Other non-formal education courses as may be prescribed by the DOH and the Bureau of Non-formal Education/Department of Education , Department of Agriculture, The Department of Science and Technology and other Government and private agencies;

SECTION XIV- CIVIL SERVICE ELIGIBILITY.

- a. Requirements in order to qualify for the grant of a first level positions by the civil service commission(Provided under Section 2 of CSC Resolution No. 992845.), the Accredited BHW and BNS applicant must:
 1. Have not been employed and has not received any form of salary, or compensation, except honorarium, in the entirety of the five year period for service requirement;
 2. Have rendered continuous for a minimum period of Five (5) years,
 3. Should be accredited by the Local Health Board before rendering the five year service requirement.

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- b. Procedure. The applicant shall submit the following documents in the approved regional office of the Civil Service:
1. A duly accomplished application form with registration fee and stamp and photograph on the spaces provided;
 2. A certificate of completion of the required training programs conducted by accredited government or non-government organization;
 3. Copies of the monthly accomplishment reports for the last five (5) years duly authenticated by the Local Health board and MNAO and with attestation of the Barangay Captain of the locality where the BHW or BNS has rendered the services;
 4. Such other documents as may require by the CSC regional office;

SECTION XV- Other Benefits.

- a. Identification Cards , duly signed by the Municipal Mayor and The Municipal Health Officer;
- b. Identification cards, duly signed by the Municipal Mayor and the Municipal Agriculturist Office;
- c. Uniforms composed of, but not limited to T-shirts, blazers (chaleco) head visor, raincoat, boots, and umbrella. etc;
- d. BHW kit consisting of, but not limited to stethoscope, blood pressure apparatus, penlight, tape measure, thermometer, scale, etc;
- e. Funeral and burial assistance.

SECTION XVI – Implementing Rules and Regulations- Within Ninety (90) days after the passage of this Ordinance, the Municipal Health Officer, Municipal Agriculturist and the Municipal Administrator shall prepare the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of this Ordinance for approval through an Executive Order by the Municipal Mayor.

SECTION XVII – Repealing Clause. – Any ordinances, resolutions, orders, rules, and regulations and other issuances of the Municipal Government of Cavinti, Laguna that are contrary or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly;

SECTION XVIII – Separability Clause. – If for any reason, any section of this ordinance, or any portion hereof or the application of such section provision, or portion hereof to any person, group, or circumstance is declared judicially invalid, or unconstitutional, the retainer shall be in full force and effect.

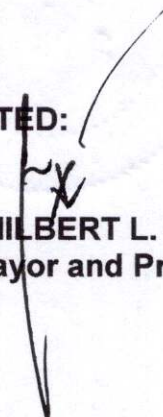

PAGTALAKAY NG PAKSA:

Sinabi ng Tagapangulo ng lupon SB Romel J. Villanueva, na kaya nito isasabatas na para makatulong ito sa mga matagal nang nanunungkulan bilang isang BNS or BHW na biglaang tatanggalin o aalisin sa kanilang tungkulin na walang anumang nakuhang sertipikasyon o anuman sa tagal nilang naglilingkod, kaya ang maganda dito katulad ni Mam Vivian may Civil service eligibility, na kahit may bagong dumating na mayor na hindi agad maaalis sa panunungkulan, yan ang kapangyarihan na ibinigay ng CSC at isa pa pwede kayong mag-aplay dito sa pamahalaang bayan, bilang regular na empelyado, kaya ito ay naisipan nya na mag-sagawa ng ganitong ordinansa sa mga inaalis na BNS at BHW. Kayo ay naging anino naming bilang isang sandata noong panahon ng pandaigdigang pandemic, kayo ang numero kasa-kasama naming at Barangay Tanod, kaya patuloy ang paggawa ng batas dahil mahal naming kayo. Isinunod ang pagbasa sa panukalang ordinansa.

Pagkatapos ng pagbasa nagtanong ang Tagapangulo ng Lupon SB Romel J. Villanueva, kung bakit nawala o naalis ang RICC sa Tanggapan ng Agrikultura?
