

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING HONORABLE MAYOR ARRANTLEE R. ARROYO OF CAVINTI, LAGUNA, TO ALLOCATE SUFFICIENT FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND COMMUNITY CLEANUP DRIVES AIMED AT PREVENTING DENGUE OUTBREAKS AND ADDRESSING ISSUES CAUSED BY THE RECENT TYPHOONS "CRISING," "EMONG," "DANTE," AND THE SOUTHWEST MONSOON.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Cavinti, Laguna has recently been affected by a series of typhoons, namely "Crising," "Emong," "Dante", as well as the southwest monsoon, resulting in widespread debris, stagnant water, and other environmental hazards:

WHEREAS, the aftermath of these natural calamities has created conditions conducive to the breeding of mosquitoes, particularly the Aedes aegypti, which is the primary vector of the dengue virus;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to implement proactive environmental and community cleanup efforts to eliminate mosquito breeding sites and ensure public health and safety;

WHEREAS, the whole Province of Laguna was officially placed under a state of calamity by Governor Sol Aragones and Sangguniang Panlalawigan on July 25, 2025, due to the cumulative effects of the recent typhoons and intensified southwest monsoon, highlighting the urgency for coordinated response and recovery efforts at the local level;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Cavinti has designated calamity funds, as mandated by law, specifically intended for disaster response, recovery, and mitigation efforts during a declared state of calamity;

WHEREAS, the participation of the local government, through the allocation of sufficient funds, is essential in the effective execution of these cleanup drives in collaboration with barangay units and community stakeholders;

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of SB Jose Mari L. Esguerra, and by unanimous consent of all other SB Members herein present, there being a quorum, it was

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to RESPECTFULLY REQUEST HONORABLE MAYOR ARRANTLEE R. ARROYO OF CAVINTI, LAGUNA, TO ALLOCATE APPROPRIATE AND SUFFICIENT FUNDS FOR THE IMMEDIATE IMPLEMENTATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL AND COMMUNITY CLEANUP DRIVES WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY AIMED AT PREVENTING DENGUE OUTBREAKS AND ADDRESSING ISSUES CAUSED BY THE RECENT TYPHOONS "CRISING," "EMONG," "DANTE," AND THE SOUTHWEST MONSOON.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the local government initiate and implement targeted programs such as fumigation and larvicide application in high-risk areas or other related measures to eliminate dengue vector breeding sites and help prevent the potential outbreak of dengue fever;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the municipal departments concerned, including the Municipal Health Office (MHO), Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), and barangay councils, be enjoined to coordinate and actively participate in the said cleanup drives to ensure their success and sustainability;

FINALLY RESOLVED, that copies of this resolution be furnished to the Office of the Municipal Mayor, the Municipal Health Office (MHO), the MENRO, and other relevant agencies for their information, guidance, and appropriate action.


